REPORT OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE

Chief Moore offered thoughts and prayers to families of Houston, Texas. On August 22, at 1400 hours, detective personnel assigned to the Gang and Narcotics Division, received information that an individual wanted for the killing of his wife and kidnapping of his son, which was the subject of an AMBER alert, was located inside an apartment in the San Fernando Valley. Detectives began a

surveillance of the location while assembling additional resources to take the person into custody. At approximately 1845 hours, a detective noted that the suspect exit the location with the victim identified in the AMBER alert. Detective personnel attempted to affect an arrest and the suspect let go of the victim. He removed a handgun and pointed it towards the officers resulting in an OIS. Los Angeles Fire Department paramedics transported the suspect to the hospital where he was pronounced dead. The victim and the officers were not injured and a gun was recovered on the scene.

Chief Moore attended the citizen academy graduation 2.0, a 14-week program. He was proud to see them graduate and proud of the task where they learned about department operations. The expansion of a program, "Shop With a Cop" is due to the generous funding of \$62,000 by Dave Anderson. Twenty-five children and 25 officers partnered with Staples to purchase supplies for school.
