Minutes of the Meeting of July 1, 2021

Welcome and Call To Order at 3:06 pm by Chairman Moises Gomez, in the Blake Community Room and via Zoom.

Review of the Minutes of the June meeting. (Posted on the web site www.olympiccpab.com) Motion to approve, second, passed.

Captain Sandoval reported a large increase in Grand Theft Auto (GTA) crime city-wide as reopening occurs. The most frequently stolen cars have become Kias (24 YTD in 2020, 59 in 2021) and Hyundais (6 in 2020 YTD and 60! in 2021). Suggestions to avoid becoming a victim include (1) leave nothing visible in the car that attracts interest; (2) Use a Club or similar steering lock; (3) never leave an unattended car running.

Chairman Gomez noted the resignation and retirement of long-time secretary Zoila Banuelos and thanked her for multiple years of loyal and excellent service to Olympic C-PAB. Robert Reeves, a long-time member of Olympic C-PAB, was introduced as the successor secretary.

The Senior Lead Officer report was not possible as the Officers were called to scheduled demonstrations.

- 3 July, Food & Backpack Giveaway organized by CHULA, 8 to 11 am. Walk up or drive up with distribution of assistance to community families. C-PAB member assistance is welcomed; volunteers are asked to arrive at 6 am; coffee and bagels provided.
- 3 August, National Night Out, Olympic Station, 5-7:30 pm. The program will differ from previous years, with a BBQ, community fair, and entertainment, all at the Olympic station. (Flyer attached)
- 15 August, Back to School Giveaway (sponsoring organization name unavailable): backpacks, school supplies, food. More than 1000 bags are available for distribution.
